AWCTS Module: ALL

Release Items	Description
HIPAA Expiring Date – fix	The HIPAA Expiring Date in user profiles now calculates correctly in ad hoc reporting across all modules.
Downloadable User Guide – new feature	All modules now have a complete User Guide embedded in the help files which is downloadable in PDF format.

AWCTS Module: Administrator

Release Items	Description
CSM Position Title – new feature	Command Sergeant Major is now an available Position Title in AWCTS WTU when the WTU Leadership Role is selected.
CSP Administrator – new feature	The CSP Administrator role is now available in WTU Admin. CSP Administrators have full permissions to manage CSP profiles and documentation and read-only access to all other AWCTS-WTU functionality.

Release Items	Description
Case Overview Chart – fix	The “Advocate Managed Cases by Status” chart on the Cases Overview page now displays the correct number of cases for all listed categories by removing the LCMP Lifecycle Phase from the calculation.
Post WTU Separation Survey Workflow – new feature	Advocates and Contact Center Operators now have a workflow to identify and track Soldiers eligible for the Post-WTU Survey. The workflow allows users to track each survey attempt and the outcome. Leadership and Supervisors will have read access to this new feature for oversight. See “ <i>Post WTU Survey Workflow</i> ” for complete information on this functionality.

AWCTS Module: OMB	
Release Items	Description
Rename Attachment – fix	Users can now rename Attachments when editing attachment details.
No Email Indicator – new feature	A “No Email – Verified” check box is now available on the Soldier Contacts page with a read-only version on the Case Information page. This data assists MAG Distro users with issue survey workflow. The check box is active for MAG Distro and Administrative users if there are no email addresses associated with the Soldier’s case (including enterprise email from the Case Information page) and read-only for all other users. If the check box is marked and an email is later added to the case, the check is automatically removed. Case logs record each application and removal of the check box. “No Email – Verified” is also available as an ad hoc entity in reports.
Prevent Issues on Cases Opened in Error – fix	Issues can no longer be created for cases with a status of “Closed - Opened in Error.”

AWCTS Module: Soldier	
Release Items	Description
Self-Assessment Summary – new feature	When viewing the Self-Assessment Summary page, Soldiers now see a limited view of Action Plans associated with each assessment category. To view facilitator, target date and plan title, hover over the number in the Action Plan column.

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AWCTS Module: WSFH	
Release Items	Description
"Assigned To" field rules – change	Users can no longer set an Issue already assigned to a user to "no assignment." New issues may be unassigned initially until assigned to a user by a shift supervisor.

AWCTS Module: WTU	
Release Items	Description
Ad Hoc Entity – new feature	Self-Assessment Status is now an available entity in ad hoc reporting. Data values include: • Active • Completed • Incomplete • Cancelled
"Assign To" Bulk Reassignment – change	The "Assign To" field no longer refreshes to blank after modifying the "Assign From" field if the users are in the same organization.
AW2 RCC Case Review Tracking – new feature	AW2 RCC users now have a dashboard to track CTP Review workflow. The dashboard is based on Tasks associated with an open Issue with the category "CTP Review." The dates reflected are based on the last completed task associated with that open issue. Names appear on the dashboard one week before the review is due.
OT Prep Tab Permissions – change	All users at a WTU with the Occupational Therapist role now have permissions to modify data on the OT Prep tab in CER Prep Activities regardless of Soldier assignment.
CER Eligibility – fix	Users can no longer update CER eligibility for Soldiers outside of their current organization.
Link to Action Plans from Self-Assessment Summary – new feature	When viewing the self-assessment summary page, users now see the number of Action Plans connected with each category. Hovering over the number will display limited details about the Action Plan with a link to open the full plan in another window.
CSP Profile Management – new feature	MEDCOM Career Skills Programs are now created and managed in AWCTS. CSP profiles include all MEDCOM approved CSPs and the associated program documentation. For complete information on creating, managing and viewing CSP profiles, see "AWCTS CSP."

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CER Non-Compliance – fix	Users can no longer update the non-compliance checkbox for Soldiers outside of their current organization.
Action Plan – Position Title (phase 2) – new feature	When creating or editing an Action Plan or Task, the facilitator is now chosen using the Position Title.
Assign to Me – Validation Action Plan – new feature	“Assign to Me” is now available when creating Action Plans during self-assessment validation. Selecting “Assign to Me” will automatically populate the role and facilitator fields.
View All Action Items – fix	When viewing the Action Items top menu, users with the “All” option will only see Action Plans within their assigned organization level.
Bulk Reassignment Grid Filter – fix	Grid filters no longer blank out the results on the Bulk Reassignment page.
Action Plan Facilitator List Order– change	Names in the facilitator drop down now consistently display in alphabetical order on all Action Plan and Task add/edit screens.
New Future Duty Type: Medical Separation – change	“Medical Separation” is now an available option in the Future Duty field when out-processing a Soldier.
Pending Assignment Grid – fix	The Pending Assignment Grid now refreshes with appropriate data when filtered.

Module	Description	Workaround
WTU	SWRA-Q data shows incorrectly in factor group ratings for assessments prior to Aug 18, 2018	When viewing factor group ratings in SWRA-Q details, items listed as “High” (orange) should be interpreted as “Moderate” (yellow) and items listed as Severe/Imminent (red) are either High or Severe/Imminent (95% of the ratings are High). This item has been prioritized for development in v.2.8.19 (Feb 2019).
WTU	Online help files do not contain CSP information	Use the AWCTS WTU User Guide for 2.8.18 available in the AWCTS Help Center

WTU-9100	CER Eligibility and Participation	Performance enhancement and addition of days since last eligibility update by M2 and CDR for Ineligible Soldiers.
WTU	Scrimmage Timeline Report	Provides a complete scrimmage and FTR history by Soldier. Additionally, the next scrimmage/FTR date is projected by AWCTS based on available case information.
WTU	AW2 RCC Last CTP Review	Contains data related to WTU Soldiers' CTP Review. This report expands on data from the CTP Review dashboard and includes all Soldiers, not just those due for a periodic review. Runs automatically based on the user's unit level and/or assigned Soldiers.
WTU	Post WTU Survey	Removed unmanaged AW2 cases from the list and corrected an issue with the link.
WTU	CTP Summary by Soldier	Corrected Last self-assessment date
WTU	Pending Risk Assessment by Soldier	Corrected formatting issues
WTU	Initial RA Timeline	Corrected percentage calculation and fixed calculation error for Soldiers in-processed in the last day
WTU	Action Plans – Open by Soldier	Update query to pull correct data for Facilitator Last Update
